An AVS Dome camera was featured on Multiflight's newly completed BBJ delivered the first week of July by Lufthansa Technik in Hamburg, Germany. A small 4.75" transparent dome located on the bottom of the aircraft fuselage, the AVS Dome camera Pans & Tilts 360° while Zooming 22X optically and may be utilized for landscape, aircraft observation and security. A PDA, Touch Screen, or Computer device may control camera functions via RS485 commands. Additionally, MapTrac® Patent Pending software is available from AVS to automatically track points of interest (POI) on the ground during flight. The camera automatically switches to Black & White at night for increased light sensitivity (.06 lux) and may be programmed with Scans, Patrols, Motion Detector and Alarms plus 50 presets. *"What would you like it to do?!"*

Also installed complimenting the telephoto AVS Dome camera, was an AVS Tail camera providing a panoramic wide angle view. Lufthansa plans to complete additional aircraft with the AVS Dome and Tail cameras including BBJ, B747 & Airbus 340.
